The base issues \$8B in contracts each year, and indirectly employs 60,000 people, many of whom live in Manhattan Beach and surrounding areas. Approved \$40,000 in 2004 to support the effort.▪ 310 Area Code Split – Worked actively with the Public Utilities Commission to oppose cell phone companies' desire to split the area code.
